Father Jeremy King, OSB, will join us as Retreat Master for the weekend.

In our initial conference, we will cover what it means to be “fully man” citing the difference between being a “male” and a “man”. We will also review a video and discuss the idea of virtue and how virtues are essential to being fully human and Christian. Subsequent conferences will consider virtues that both Aristotle and Saint Augustine consider essential to being “fully man”.

Fr. Jeremy King, OSB, was born in Jeffersonville, Indiana, September 4, 1947 and went to grade school at Saint Augustine and Sacred Heart Schools. He attended Saint Meinrad Seminary High School and College and made his first vows as a Benedictine monk in 1971. He was ordained a priest in 1975. After ordination he earned a Masters Degree in College Administration from Indiana University.

He taught Sacraments and Liturgy in the Seminary College and School of Theology. He served as Choirmaster of the Archabbey for a total of fourteen years. He also served in parish ministry for fifteen years. He is currently involved in Ministry to the Incarcerated.
