Attribute - God of Obedience

Praise: Deuteronomy 6:4-9

Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD alone! Therefore, you shall love the LORD, your God, with your whole heart, and with your whole being, and with your whole strength. Take to heart these words which I command you today. Keep repeating them to your children. Recite them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you get up. Intercession: John 14:15-21

But you know it, because it remains with you, and will be in you. I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.
