St Francis Xavier: 5 lessons to inspire people (Fr Roland Coelho, SJ | MARCH 11, 2022)

- 1. **Inner transformation** Xavier's life teaches us to be open to inner transformation.
- 2. **Humble service** Xavier's life teaches us to serve humbly. In today's world where many leaders make a show of bravado and trumpet their deeds before others, Xavier's life teaches us to be humble. He stooped to conquer. He had everything before him: he was on track to have a great life at the University of Paris. Here, power, fame and wealth were within his easy reach. But he chose another path, that of giving up everything and working to spread the Gospel message of God's love and mercy. On May 6, 1542, Xavier entered the waters of Goa, India, sailed down the Mandovi River and finally disembarked at Old Goa. He chose to stay at the local hospital rather than the palatial quarters of the Bishop, so as to be more easily available for service to the local people.
- 3. **Mission-focused** Xavier inspires us to keep our feet moving. He was a man on fire with God's love!
- 4. **Adaptive skills** We learn from Xavier to be flexible. Xavier changed when they experienced God's Spirit in new ways.
- 5. **Joyful generosity** Xavier's life inspires us to move from mediocrity to joyful generosity for God's greater glory.
