



Dear Parents,

Thank you for allowing your son to participate in the Senior Wilderness Retreat scheduled for **April 19-21, 2023**. We will leave around 11:00 am on Wednesday, the 19<sup>th</sup> and return at approximately 3pm on Friday, the 21<sup>st</sup>. We are very aware that Senior Prom is on Friday and will try to return even sooner. However, delays are always possible on the return trip, so please do not make any plans for your son before 5pm on Friday. It is preferred that your son not leave a car on campus during the retreat. If you have no other options, please have him see Mr. Tony Scheler for permission to leave a car.

We are going to be camping in the Red River Gorge section of the Daniel Boone National Forest. The nearest town is Slade, KY. We will be camping in tents at a primitive campsite on Tunnel Ridge Road. We will be camped off the Archaic, Fort Ancient, Paleo, or Tar Kiln parking areas (campsites are first-come, first-served, so we will not know which one until we arrive). Any U.S. Forest Service ranger will know where these areas are located.

We will meet with the group of students and go over this list in more detail. If there is anything on the list that he does not have, please let us know, as we may be able to provide some things. We do not intend for you to have to buy anything for this retreat.

Your son should come to school on Wednesday, the 19<sup>th</sup> in regular school dress. He should make sure his camping clothes are readily accessible, though, as he will need to change before leaving. Please make sure your son brings plenty of warm clothes. I would recommend a sleeping bag that is rated for at least 30° or lower. If your son's sleeping bag is rated higher than that, or does not have a rating, I would recommend bringing a warm blanket, in addition to the sleeping bag. We usually experience at least some rain on these retreats, so please make sure he brings some sort of rain gear. **Because of the slim, but increasing risk of bears in the gorge, please make sure your son does not bring any food with him.** We will provide all food and ensure that it is safely stored.

If finances are an issue for you right now, let us know, as we can work out some arrangements to make sure your son is able to participate in this retreat.
