



TIGERS in the CITY / SOPHOMORE RETREAT

This retreat connects retreatants with a social service agency. By spending time with people they might not otherwise encounter, retreatants begin to recognize the humanity of those who might be poor, developmentally disabled, or disadvantaged. Transcending the world's labels to encounter the Christ hidden within forgotten people, young people allow their lives to be transformed so that they in turn might transform the world. Students who attend this retreat will receive three hours of Direct Service.
