SOPHOMORE SERVICE REQUIREMENT INFORMATION
2022-2023

The following information will help you begin and carry out your service requirement as a sophomore at Saint Xavier High School. **Please read over the information CAREFULLY and discuss this with your parents.**

I. SERVICE PROGRAM DATES and REQUIREMENTS:

Service program begins May 1, 2022 or after freshman year requirement is complete, whichever date is later. Take advantage of the SUMMER INCENTIVE. Complete 10 hours of approved service by August 14, 2022 and your sophomore service requirement will be completed.

II. SERVICE CRITERIA: The service program is based on the Xaverian Brothers mission to reach out to the poor and marginalized. At least half of your service must incorporate work where you are serving disadvantaged or marginalized people or agencies that work with them.

III. SERVICE THAT IS NOT APPROVED

- Volunteering for your own family, grandparents, etc. IS NOT ACCEPTED SERVICE for the program.
- You cannot "Double Dip." If your hours count for KYA, KUNA, Eagle Scout, etc., you cannot also include them for sophomore service.

IV. RESPONSIBILITY

- It is your responsibility to find and arrange service opportunities. You will need assistance from family and St. X, but it is your service requirement, not theirs.
- The sophomore year is busy and demanding. We highly encourage you to complete hours over the summer.

V. FINDING SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

- Family contacts with social agencies, hospitals, and nursing homes.
- "Events" link on MobileServe to sign up for projects. They will be posted year round.
- Join Ryken Service Club.
- Check with your parish or youth group for service opportunities.

VI. SUBMITTING SERVICE HOURS

- HOURS WILL BE REJECTED IF YOU DO NOT PUT IN THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION: Name of Project, Description, Supervisor name and email.
- You must have 2 forms of verification: Supervisor Email + (Photo, Signature or Geo-location).
- You must write a description of the project on MobileServe. Understand that your contact person will be able to read your description and reflection, so be appropriate.
- A history of your approved hours will be recorded on MobileServe. You can access this history when filling out college resumes on Naviance and when you begin to fill out college applications.
- If you cannot find the name of supervisor, please use your parent and his or her email.

VII. CHECKING STATUS OF SUBMITTED PROJECTS

- Periodically check hours on MobileServe App to see your approved hours.
- Comments will be sent to you on whether hours were approved or denied.
- If denied, in most cases you will be allowed to resubmit as long as you provide the verification information that is incomplete.

VIII. GRADING

- You will receive a completion grade for each of the first 2 quarters in your theology class.
- The final 1/3 of your hours must be completed by Monday, April 10. You will receive a 4th quarter completion grade for completing your hours.
- There will be an assessment on your service experience that will be take place in the 4th quarter
